Students who had completed a prior empirical master’s thesis may be able to waive the thesis requirement, pending approval by two thesis readers.

Note. Amounts shown are for first year (12 months) in the program. In-residence students are full-time only. Health insurance is provided by WSU at no charge. All incoming students receive a 20-hour graduate assistantship with a tuition waiver and a 9-month stipend of \$14,305.50 for pre-master's students (\$15,178.50 for post-master's students). Based on Washington state law, students are required to contribute \$955 per semester toward fees.

***Based on up to 18 credit hours in Fall and Spring.** These tuition fees are waived in conjunction with a 20-hour graduate assistantship.
